## NEEDS AND JUSTIFICATION FOR RUSA GRANTS

Dhing College was established in 1965 and accredited B\*+ by NAAC in 2016. Dhing College is the only degree college with Arts, Science & Commerce streams in the catchment area with a radius of 30 (thirty) Kms in North Western part of undivided Nagaon-Morigaon district of Assam. The college aims at continual extension of the first degree education like B.A ,B.Sc and B.Com in traditional subjects as well as modern subjects permitted by the affiliating University of Gauhati and the UGC. Preparing the students for responsible citizenship and making them eligible for the challenges of modern civilization is an implicit objective of the College.

After the assessment of 2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle by NAAC in 2016, the college authority and the IQAC convened meetings in several times where the authority had discussed about the strengths & weaknesses of the college based on NAAC peer team recommendation. After several round of discussion it was decided that the college should approach RUSA in order to get financial support for infrastructural & instrumental development of the college. The item wise justification for achieving financial grant from RUSA has been prepared on the basis of recommendations given by NAAC peer Team which is given below.

## A] New Facilities Required: (Rs. 100 lakhs as per RUS.4 Guidelines)

- 1. Toilets (Separate for Boys & Girls): Dhing College has the student strength of 1235 students in current year out of which 612 are girl students. There is a small number of toilet facilities in the college which is insufficient to meet the need of the students. So considering the availability of space in the campus it will be appropriate to have central toilet facility including sensor.
- 2. Laboratory: There is a lack of permanent RCC laboratory in the college for the subjects like Botany, Chemistry, Geography and Education. Although we have two laboratories for Zoology & Physics but these are not sufficient for increased number of student in science stream.

- The NAAC peer team had advised/ recommended us to have vertical construction of RCC Block for Science Stream.
- 3. Class Room (including technically enabled Class Rooms): The construction of Class room is a pressing need in the planning of development activity of the college in future. This is due to the growing / increasing number of students in the college. In our college the number of teacher and students ratio has been inadequate. In such a situation the number of Class rooms should be sufficient. NAAC peer team has strongly recommended to us to have more class rooms including technically enabled Class Room facilities in future to minimize the disproportionate ratio. It is an opportunity for the College to teach the students to use modern ICT facilities.
- 4. Common Room for Students: The students' democratic rights should have an important role in smooth functioning of the college. So, they should be given top priority and all facilities should be provided to them. But in our college there is a shortage of well constructed students' Common Room with proper amenities. Considering this, it was decided to construct separate common rooms for boys and girls.
- 5. Canteen/Cafeteria: Due to increasing number of students the present temporary canteen is not sufficient to meet the growing need of students and faculty. More over there was a public demand that the canteen should be established on road side direction for provision of sales during vacation period and holidays. Students are demanding a separate portion to be used as Canteen Building. The College is proposing to construct a dining hall, kitchen with pantry and two separate toilet (He & She separately). College proposes an amount of Rs. 15.0 Lakh for the same.
- B] Renovation / Upgradation of Existing Facilities: (Rs. 60 lakhs as per RUSA Guidelines)
  - 1 Academic Building: For proper evaluation of examination scripts, internal and University Examinations, a separate academic building is extremely necessary for the College. The NAAC peer team also advised us to set up a necessary for the College to make teaching, learning and evaluation separate academic building to make teaching, learning and evaluation process more effective.

- 2 Administrative building: In existing Administrative Block the principal's amenities.

- of land. It has two campuses. For campus development we need fund for and gardening.

  Campus development: We have a big College campus. It is about 25 acres internal road, boundary wall, motor car & cycle parking, drainage system
- 4 Hostel: There are two Girls' Hostels and one Boys' Hostel in the old campus of Dhing College. The existing infrastructure of Boys' Hostel is inadequate to meet the growing needs and demands of the tremendous growth of the number of aspiring students in this College, the old Boys Hostel Building need to be renovated with a grant of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs.
- Class Rooms: Dhing College is a three tier college having arts, science & commerce. Due to increasing number of students the class room ratio per students is totally disproportionate. The growing demand for admission every year, the College has been unable to provide admission to all students due to shortage of Class Rooms. To cope with the growing demand for admission every year, the College has got to renovate the existing Class Rooms.
- 6 Auditorium: The existing college auditorium was not complete before the coming of NAAC Peer team in 2016. During Exit meeting the NAAC peer team reportedly informed us that before coming 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle of assessment the remaining work of the Auditorium should be completed to get good grade.
- 7 Laboratory: The existing laboratories of the departments of Chemistry, Botany, Geography and Education are need to be renovate with adequate space and other facilities.

# C] New Equipments / Facilities: (Rs. 40.0 lakh as per RUSA Guidelines)

1 Sports facilities: Our College had received grants from UGC for construction of Outdoor and Indoor stadium which are already in well existence in the campus? The UGC did not give us money for existence in the campus? sports equipments for which the students procurement of necessary sports

adequate modern sports facilities to its students at present and in RUSA in form of finance to procure hi-tech equipments.

2 Computer for Computer Room: In our college, there is a compulsory there is also an parallel option for students to take basic computer conduct such programme due to the scarcity of computers. In view of all these needs we want to approach to RUSA for seeking assistance.

3 Laboratory equipments: Due to increasing number of students in science subjects and frequent up-gradation of syllabus & practical more number of equipments are required by each and every department. Considering the demand of equipments as per syllabus, laboratory

equipments are required urgently.

4 Books and Journals: For growing demand of new books and journals more number of books is necessary for the library. In addition, for faculty members more number of e books and e-journals are necessary. There is a shortage of Books & Journals in our Library as the enrolment of the College increasing every year. The students are unable to purchase the reference books due to their financial inabilities. As the College is in the process of development, sufficient stock of books is the first requirement and priority for the College. A humble proposal amounting to Rs. 10.0 Lakh is submitted herewith for the purchase of Books & Journals.
