(from-2019) degree from this institution and subject to unemployed for many years; somebody never get chance to establish in life, it is more pathetic to us. #### DHING COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

The Dhing College is established in the North-Western part of Nagaon district of Assam in the day of 20th July, 1965. The latitudinal and longitudinal lines crosses each other at 26°27' 45" and 92° 29' 20". Likely, the Dhing College is made of and located at Dhing by the full cooperation of all the communities such as Baisnabite group of Assamese people, a few families of Jainism of Dhing and Moirabari, Muslim, Bengali Hindus, Nepalies, Schedule Tribe group of people from undivided Nowgong district are the major interested communities. It is also fact that the college is located within the most backward rural areas, about 90% of total population belonging to illiterate and came from poor ones. In The time of establishment the college was only a single stream of Arts. In the 1988 the Science stream started and in 1998 it was in full placed stream. From 2017 the College Governing Body extended the Commerce stream along with Arts and Science. In the current session i.e. 2019-20 bearing enrolment of about 1516. The Dhing College is located in the heart of the Dhing Town Committee (DTC) and the DTC is established in 1970 with 4 Wards and extended to 10 Wards in the year 2003, where, total geographical area of 18 square kilometer. The college observed posthumously the renewed DAYS like Tithi of Sri Sri Madhava Deva, Tithi of Sri Sri Sankar Deva, Gandhi Jayanti, Saraswati Puja, Subhas Bose Day, Silpi Diwas, International Yoga Diwas, Republic Day, Independence Day, etc. and functions has been posthumously conducted in the college premises and served through the guidelines from the respected Principal, Dr. Biman Hazarika of the college. In all the significant functions of the renewed Days expenses by the individual headings and from the College Management Fund.

RUNNING COURSES / STREAMS IN DHING COLLEGE: Since its inception, there are single stream i.e. Arts with the subjects like- English, Assamese, Political Science, Economics, History, Geography, Education and Bengali. All the Arts subject Major / Honours courses except Bengali. It is realized that the Dhing College authority and the initiation of Governing Body Members interacting to introduce Science Stream for the greater interest of the North-West undivided Nowgong District for their poor. Absolutely, the Science Stream has been opened in the college premises under the same banner of the authority in the year 1988. The Science Stream has gone under the Govt. Aided scheme in the year 1998. Both the stream like Arts and Science is also undertaken Govt. Provincialization Role, 2005 at the same lot of Assam Provincialised Colleges Act, 2005. As well as, the Commerce Stream is settled to establish herewith the common interest of the people in the 2016-17 session.

MAJOR COURSES: Except Bengali all other subjects like English, Assamese, Political Science, Economics, History, Geography, Education, etc. covering under Major Courses in the Arts stream. In the Science Stream subjects like Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany and Zoology) and Mathematics merging with Major Course( now it is so called Honours Course). In Commerce Stream Accountancy and Banking have Major Courses only.

GENERAL COURSES: All the above mentioned subjects in Arts and Science stream the college maintained as general courses also and in addition Assamese 2<sup>nd</sup> Language, English 2<sup>nd</sup> Language, Bengali 2<sup>nd</sup> Language and Functional English as Elective subjects. Gauhati University other Affiliated courses like- (1) Indira Gandhi National Open University or (IGNOU Study Centre), (2) Krishna Kanta Sandique State University Centre, (3) Biotech Hub,(4) Fish and Fisheries and (5) Computer Training Centre.

VILLAGE / TOWN LEVEL EDUCATIONAL STATUS AROUND DHING: The Dhing Town surrounded by villages Bilotia and Auniati Satra located in the East, Dhupaguri Dhaccaiya Basti and Dhupaguri Kachari Gaon in the South, Sonari Gaon and Barbheti Gaon in the West and in East the villages — Lahkar, Hatimuria. and Tatelia Gaon so called Athgaon Chapori. Dhing College is located in the heart of the Dhing Town. Dhing Town Committee (D.T.C.) established in 1970 with 4 Wards only and its total geographical area about 18 Square Kilometers. According to increased population pattern of the Town, 4 Wards extended to 10 in the year 2003. Its total population and literacy rate as in the year 1971 was-10778 and 5849 (54.27% literate); in 2001- 17844 and 12896 and literacy rate 72.27% and in 2011- 19235 and 15085; its literacy rate 78.42%

#### WORKS PERFORMS BY NSS VOLUNTEER TEAM, DHING COLLEGE:

INTRODUCTION: The village viz. Kandhulimari-03 (part of Auniati Satra is under the Dhing Revenue Circle in the district of Nagaon, Assam. The total geographical area of the village is about 422 acres (166.28 hectres). In 1971, the village had carried only 744 of its total population and the literacy rate enjoyed only 36.02%. As well as, the Adopt Village –Kandhulimari-03, so called Auniati Satra increase its total population in the tune of 1150 and the literacy rate gone up to 84.43% in the Census year 2011. There are about 50 % of the total families directly depend on agriculture.

PHYSIOGRAPHY OF ADOPT VILLAGE: Kandhulimari-03 under the Auniati Satra of Dhing Revenue Circle is entirely located in the plain region of the mighty River Brahmaputra. Due its plainness in characteristics of the relief feature —at first, the land is very fertile alluvial soil, which support multiple cropping in the year round; secondly, above 60% of the total families directly depend on agricultural productions as their livelihood; thirdly, the surplus amount of vegetable production of various kinds, and the surplus products supply to either other districts of Assam nor the other states of N.E. India especially in Nagaland, Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh. The local market facility along with road connectivity to others is qualitatively medium in range of supply of the agro-products. Finally, the area covered with dense settlement about more than 300 persons per square kilometer.

DHING EXPRES-HIMA DAS: So we, offer heartiest THANKS to GU NSS Executives and Programme Coordinator, who allowed NSS fund to the respective colleges of Assam including Dhing College. The Principal of the college is guided in all the respective Days by the 2 wing members / leaders of the wing and teaching and non-teaching staffs.

The village Adoption Committee including the Principal of the college and Programme Officer is jointly selected the Kandhulimari -03 (part of Auniati Gaon) a very fruitful site as Adopt Village and the Auniati-Sologuri Prathamik Vidhyalaya where "DHING EXPRESS & GOLD MEDALIST" HIMA DAS was born and completed his Primary Education successfully. So, it is best for research work on socio-economic status of the Kandulimari village, where she born. DHING EXPRES- HIMA DAS: The National Service Scheme (NSS) Executive Committee headed by the Ex-Principal, Dr. Sarat Kumar Dutta, the standing Principal Dr. Biman Hazarika and Programme Officer N.S.S. Cell & I.C.G.C. Assistant Coordinator Abdur Rashid of Dhing College recommended the village Kandhulimari gaon-03 part of Auniati Satra is only a Gaon where, no single family from General Caste seen except the Schedule Caste people belonging there. Their socio-economic conditions are not good compared to any other Caste nearby. On the other hand, the Dhing College National Service Scheme Unit immense pride to acknowledge and appreciate the World Class Achievement of Miss Hima Das, DHING EXPRESS in the field of Athletics is also born in Kandhulimari Gaon-03. On behalf of humble gesture of its LOVE for her, the college through its staffs, non-teaching staffs, NCC-Officer, Dr. Mriganka Saikia and Cadres and NSS Unit is privileged to donate some articles and educational aids to Auniati-Solaguri Balika Prathamik Vidhyalaya, where, Miss Hima Das's primary education completed.

So, it is very important to identify the villagers activities on games & sports or any other events and to know the world of people where, deteriorated present day economic conditions is not a matter; specially from where MISS HIMA DAS came to a world figure in Athletics.

EDUCATIONAL STATUS OF THE ADOPT VILLAGE: The Right to Children for Free and Compulsory Education Act or Right to Education (RTE), is an Act of the Parliament of India enacted on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2009; which describe the modalities of the importance of Free and Compulsory Education for children between 6–14 in India under Article 21a of the Indian Constitution.

In India, the literacy rate was about 18.33% in 1951 and it increased to the tune of 74.04% by the year 2011. Accordingly, in Assam the literacy rate increases smoothly since 1951 to 2011; by the year 1951 (18.53%), 1961 (32.95%), 1971 (33.94%), 1991 (52.89), 2001 (63.25%), and in 2011(73.18) respectively (No census was held in Assam and J and K, in 1981).

In recent census year 2011, the Auniati Satra as a whole the literacy rate is about 84.43%, highest in national average of about 74.04%. The Adopt village Kandhulimari -03, overall percentage of literacy rate is about 49.52% considering the age group in between 0 - 6; where, male and female literacy rate comparatively more low than the Auniati Satra, it is cleared.

ADOPT BALIKA PRATHAMIK BIDYALAYA: Hima Das was studied the Primary level of Education from Auniati Balika Vidyalaya which is recently amalgamated with 228 No. Auniati Solaguri Prathamik Vidyalaya on 01.02.2018 follow-up by the Govt. Circular basis on 01.02.2018. She reading up to class-iv in the year 2008 and her Roll No. was 03. Hima Das was completed the Middle School Course from Dhing Public High School, Dhing. Finaly, Hima Das likely to be the Higher Secondary (Final) examination passed with a good scoring marks from Dhing College Centre, Dhing 2019.

Finally, the Dhing College NSS Executive Committee members Headed by Dr. Sarat Kumar Dutta, Principal, Dhing College to accommodate some essential educational aids, where, the last educational carrier has been completed by HIMA DAS. As suggestion, the NSS Programme Officer self, Principal of the college and Students Secretary of NSS jointly discussed for the Educational Aids. FAMILY HISTORY OF HIMA DAS: Hima Das was born in a poor family in Kandhulimari village of Nagaon district, Assam. Her parent Ranjit Das and Jonali Das belong to the indigenous Kaibarta community. Both of them do farming to support the family. She is the youngest of five children. She attended the Dhing Public High School, where, Hima Das studied the Middle School up to the Matriculation and was initially interested in playing football. She played football with the boys at her schooland has always wanted to pursue a carrier in football. However, she did not any prospects for herself in Women's Football. Later, upon advice from a school teacher, and then, she change to sprint running.

CHILD LIFE OF HIMA DAS: Miss Hima Das is born in the year 9th January 2000, in the village Kandhulimari -03 of AuniatiSatra under the Revenue Circle-Dhing in the district of Nagaon, Assam. Her father's name Mr. Ranjit Das and mothers name's Mrs. Jonali Das. Presently, her height is about 5 6 (i.e. 1.67 metres) with a weight of 52 kilogram. According to the old aged persons said that around 4.0 a.m. she came to the nearby playground with her father for run, in some occasion a few boys and girls participated with her for a short time; but she runs at least 3hours continuously. Some of them highlighted that she (HIMA) very loudly crying when she feels harm too much. After her a firm decision and trial she go to time bound run has been strictly decided for few moments and then joined in District Level Games. As much, she continuously exercised through runs up to the age of 17 years. In school games and the inter school games she shows the excellent performance in 'RACE', but not in others, it is stated.

In over a year, she was a District Champions but took almost 2 years to reach the State Level Competition. In early2016, she won the 100m Race at the State Championships and later at the same year made to the finals of Junior Athletic Championships in Ciombatore without any training and stunning all.

Nipon Das heartily suggest to participate in 100 and 200m Race. But, she shift to 400m came when coaches spotted that she used to start slow and peaked in the end, meaning a perfect Athlete for 400m sprint. It was in May 2017, A. Malaker and N. Das made her run 400m in Guwahati. Hima clocked 57 seconds.

PRESENT EDUCATIONAL STATUS OF HIMA DAS: Miss. Hima Das passed the Higher Secondary (Final) examination, 2019 from Dhing College Centre.

FIRST TRACK OF HIMA: (a) On 12 July, 2018 Hima won the 400 metres final at the World U-20 Championships, 2018 held at Tempere (Finland) clocking at 51.46 seconds and becoming the first Indian sprinter to won a GOLD MEDAL at an International Event.

(b) Hima Das (Born in 9 January, 2000), nick named the DHING EXPRESSis an Indian sprinter runner from the State of Assam. She holds the current India in National Recordin 400metres with a timing of 50.79 seconds at the Asian Games in Jakarta (Indonesia). She is he first Indian athlete to won a GOLD MEDAL in a track event at the IAAF (International Association of Athletics Federation) World Under-20 Championships.

Hima is also won other 2 Silver Medal at Asian Games in Jakarta, 2018.

No women before Hima has won a Gold Medal in World Championships at any level, be it youth, junior or senior.

(c) In April 2018, Hima completed in the 2018 Common Wealth Games at Gold Coast, Australiain the 400metres and the 4x400metres Relay. In the 400 metres, she reached the final where she finished 6th in a time of 51.32 seconds, 1.17 seconds behind

gold medallist AmantleMontsho from Botswana. In the 4x400 metres Relay she was part of the Indian team that finished 7<sup>th</sup>in the final, with a time of 3 minutes and 33.61 seconds.

(d) At the Asian Games, Hima qualified for the 400m final after clocking 51.00in heat 1 and anew Indian National Record. On 26 August 2018, she improved the National Record to 50.79 secondsin the 400m final to win the Silver Medal. On 30 August,2018 Hima along with M R Povamma, Sarita Gayakwadand V K Vismaya won the Women's 4x400 m Relay clocking 3. 28.72. Earlier on the same Day Hima failed to qualify for the final of the 200 m Race, due to a false start in a Semi-final. Hima also won a Silver Medal 4x400 m Mixed Relay, which was held for the first time at Asian Games.
